

To the Grand Temples the Supreme Temple will be asking for nomination for the Supreme Secretaries position, the nominees should be computer savvy, we will also need a Supreme Guard, so talk it over in your respective locations to ensure that your Supreme Representatives know the will of the Grand Temple sisters. From the Supreme Secretary's Desk

With only a few months before the 81<sup>st</sup> Supreme Lodge Convention, things in the office are, as should be expected, hectic. Almost half the Annual Reports and Per Capita Tax payments due have not been submitted, leaving those Grand Lodge subject to fines – we were not looking to turn this into a fund raiser for the Supreme Lodge, but it would appear it is.

At the Supreme Lodge Convention held in Newark, New Jersey last August, four domains were not seated. First was the Domain of the District of Columbia, it had its Charter suspended by a vote of the Supreme Council some months earlier, for various violations of Supreme Law (they later had their Charter revoked by a vote of the body at the 2021 Supreme Lodge Convention). There were also three Grand Lodges that owed reports and sizable amounts of money to the Supreme Lodge for Per Capita Tax over several years, and finally action was taken not to seat them. To date, the Supreme Lodge has received an updated Annual Report and arrearages from one of those Grand Lodges, but not from the other two. Will they be seated at the 2022 Supreme Lodge Convention in South Carolina later this year?

The Supreme Lodge is now accepting credit cards for your purchases of Pythian Paraphernalia, and/or your Domain's Per Capita Tax payment.

I'd like to wish Our Brothers, Sisters and their families the best for a Sweet Passover and Happy Easter.

# GREETINGS FROM THE SUPREME LODGE KNIGHTS OF PYTHIAS FOUNDATION.

The Last 2-1/2 years have been a challenge for the Foundation Trustees. The Supreme Lodge Convention was postponed multiple times, and financial market fluctuations were an interminable concern. We have navigated these uncertain times very well, so far, through the constant diligence of the Trustees, Supreme Treasurer, and our Wells Fargo Brokers. Securing the \$1.5 million foundation corpus has been our primary goal during the last 6 years. We have moved most of that amount into Treasuries and CD's to insure it for perpetuity. The interest and dividends of our portfolio have allowed us to meet all our obligations to Supreme Lodge and the Rathbone Memorial Society. We have also donated \$75,000 to Feeding America during the darkest days of the Covid pandemic, and \$10,000 to Kentucky when a devastating tornado destroyed 75% of the town of Dawson Springs. As of February 1, 2022, our total Foundation balance was \$2.1 million.

We appreciate the confidence our Pythian Brothers have placed in us. Rest assured, we are committed to solid financial strategy and the success of our Supreme Council in all their endeavors for the benefit of our Noble Order.


