Supreme Secretary's Massage

One last item. The deadline for the filing of regular filed legislation for the Supreme Lodge was May 30. Any such legislation not so prefiled, may be received or presented to the convention for action, if its filed with the Supreme Secretary by noon of the first day of the Supreme Lodge Convention, bearing the written approval of the Supreme Chancellor, the Supreme Vice Chancellor, and three Supreme Representatives representing separate grand lodges, or, in the absence of the approvals by the Supreme Chancellor and Supreme Vice Chancellor, with the written approvals of ten Supreme Representatives present representing separate grand lodges. In either case, such propositions or resolutions will need be read in full during the morning session of the second day of the convention, without debate, and referred to the Supreme Lodge forthwith sitting as a Committee of the Whole and the Committee on Law, to be reported to the convention for final action on the following or any later day of the convention, for adoption, disapproval, or tabling of the report of the committee of the whole, and final action upon the proposition or resolution. The foregoing requirement for submission and filing by not later than the June 1st immediately preceding a Supreme Lodge Convention, in person, or by certified or registered mail, postmarked no later than May 30th preceding such convention, and the foregoing requirement for mailing of propositions and resolutions to members of Supreme Lodge, shall not apply to propositions or resolutions submitted in written, typewritten, or similar form, in triplicate, signed by or on behalf of the Supreme Council, provided that same has received the concurring votes of at least a majority of all of the members of the Supreme Council. Confused? I hope not.

YORKTOWN LODGE, KNIGHTS OF PYTHIAS DONATES TO PTSD UNIT AT MONTROSE VETERANS HOSPITAL

In a very informative and emotional evening, members of Yorktown Lodge, Knights of Pythias, presented a \$1000 donation to members of the Military Order of the Purple Heart Chapter 21. At the meeting several members of the Purple Heart Chapter expressed their own experiences with PTSD upon returning from the Vietnam War. They explained the benefits of the current program in helping our veterans (especially the youngest) in helping them adapt to returning to a 'normal' life.

The PTSD program at the Veterans Administration in Montrose maintains a 42-bed unit where veterans can spend 4 weeks working thru their trauma. Many of these individuals are alone, often having insufficient clothes or the skills to face the non-military world. Emphasis is on helping them thru holiday times (which are the most difficult) and things that are most often taken for granted: preparing for job interviews, obtaining a driver's license as well as dealing with the experiences they have lived through.

The PTSD program is recognized world-wide for its uniqueness and accomplishments.
