A Message From Supreme Chancellor D. Mark Mead, KGS Fall is here. Cooler temperatures along with Pumpkin Spice everything is at every turn. For Supreme Lodge Officers, fall means, a number of Grand Lodge visits. All Pythians are encouraged to participate and be part of the Grand Lodge experience. Whether you have taken the Grand Lodge degree or not, you are allowed to attend most of the session. And, more importantly, your opinions matter just as much to the Supreme Lodge representatives and officers. Maintaining our focus on membership is crucial along with progressing our Order to meet the changing needs of the community remains key as we move into 2023. When you see a Supreme Lodge Officer at Grand Lodge, ask questions. The Supreme Lodge directly supports the needs of all the Grand Domains.

Membership - We have started a new initiative through our membership program – it is the 2023 Six Pack Club. While this may sound like a new beverage container, this is a program to recognize the individual that brings in at least six members over the next year. Details are in this Pythian International, but basically, your lodge secretary sends a report of the achievement to your Grand Lodge District Deputy Supreme Chancellor (DSC). A unique pin and certificate will be sent out to the member who recruited new candidates.

Also, many in the Order don't know, but Pythian hats are provided as an additional incentive. The new member as well, as the member who recruited them, are eligible to receive a hat – one hat per person, please.

Knight of the Golden Spur (KGS) – Many domains don't take advantage of the very special recognition for a variety of reasons. There are multiple steps involved and some work involved. But don't let that stop you from getting impactful recognition for that special Pythian. Ask how you can get the process started.


